# LOGISTICS ORDER

The Court enters the following logistical order and instructions in preparation for the trial of the above-stated matters.

## A. <u>Deposition Transcripts</u>

The Court **ORDERS** the Parties to provide the Court with courtesy copies of the deposition transcripts that they intend to introduce into evidence at the Trial. The Court **ORDERS** these courtesy copies be delivered to the Court no later than **THURSDAY**, **AUGUST 24**, **2023**.

The courtesy copies should be organized in the following manner. The first tab shall include the deposition in full and highlight the portions of the testimony they intend to introduce into the Trial. All portions agreed to by the Parties shall be highlighted in yellow, all portions that the Plaintiffs wish to offer but Defendants object to shall be highlighted in orange, and all portions that Defendants wish to offer but Plaintiffs object to shall be highlighted in blue.
