

over two weeks away. The facts of this case and the relevant law have already been extensively briefed by the Parties since this case was brought in 2014. Furthermore, plaintiff and defense counsel have shown themselves to be more than capable of responding to a motion in a short time frame, and, thus, Defendant's request for ten days is unreasonable under the present circumstances.

Accordingly, Plaintiff's Motion to Expedite (Doc. 219) is **GRANTED** as follows: Sumter County's response is due **no later than Tuesday, August 7, 2018**, and Plaintiff's reply is due **no later than Friday, August 10, 2018**. The Parties shall also inform the Court **no later than Friday, August 3, 2018** as to whether a hearing is necessary on the Motion for an Injunction (Doc. 218).
