According to that statute, "A district court of three judges shall be convened . . .

when an action is filed challenging the constitutionality of the apportionment of congressional districts or the apportionment of any statewide legislative body."

The present action challenges the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's congressional districts as violating the one-person, one-vote principle of the Equal Protection

Clause of Section 1 of the Fourteenth Amendment. As such, it challenges the constitutionality of the apportionment of congressional districts, and a three-judge court is warranted. In support of this motion, Plaintiffs rely on their supporting memorandum of law which will be filed within ten (10) days pursuant to Rules 7.3 and 7.5 of the Local Rules of Court.
