MOTION TO DECLARE DEADLINE

Plaintiffs Richard Vieth, Norma Jean Vieth, and Susan Furey respectfully submit this motion to declare a deadline of February 18, 2002 for the

courts of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to have completed action on the Commonwealth's congressional districting plans. As discussed in the attached memorandum of law, a deadline of February 18, 2002, is consistent with the principles of *Growe v. Emison*, 507 U.S. 25 (1993), because it gives the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, including its courts, ample time to complete its work on redistricting, while also ensuring that this Court can take appropriate action to hear any remaining federal law claims. That deadline will allow the state courts sufficient time to proceed with litigation currently pending on these matters, but will still ensure that the federal court has time enough to act with minimal disruption to the Commonwealth's election schedule. Plaintiffs also request that the Court direct the parties to file a report on February 1, 2002 concerning the

status of the state court litigation and to advise the Court as to whether any additional action is appropriate.
