#### **BACKGROUND**

- 1. The 2020 Census' apportionment counts show that Pennsylvania is entitled to 17 seats in the United States House of Representatives.
- 2. Pennsylvania's current congressional map was last drawn in 2018 by the Pennsylvania Supreme Court.
- 3. Pennsylvania's current congressional map contains 18 districts, based on the 2010 Census' apportionment count.

### POPULATION IN PENNSYLVANIA

- 4. According to the 2020 Census, Pennsylvania's population is 13,002,700.
- 5. The 2010 Census reported that Pennsylvania's population was 12,702,379.
- 6. The ideal district population for Pennsylvania's 17 congressional districts is 764,864 or 764,865 persons.
- 7. Three of Pennsylvania's counties—Philadelphia, Allegheny, and Montgomery—have total populations that exceed the ideal district population of 764,864 or 764,865 persons.
