

ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION TO MODIFY SCHEDULING ORDER

This matter came before the Court on Plaintiffs' Unopposed Motion to Modify the Scheduling Order filed April 10, 2023 ("Motion"). Having considered the Motion, the file, and otherwise being fully informed in the matter it is hereby **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED**:

Plaintiffs' Motion is **GRANTED**. Plaintiffs are permitted to serve one supplemental expert report on Monday, April 10, 2023. Defendants shall serve response reports, if necessary, by Monday, April 24, 2023, and Plaintiffs shall serve a reply report, if necessary, by Friday, April 28, 2023. This round of supplemental reports will exclusively address draft redistricting plans created by Adam Foltz. The Parties are also permitted an extension to complete depositions by June, 14, 2023. The remaining deadlines set out in the Scheduling Order dated September 29, 2022 shall remain the same.
