ORDER

This matter issues the following Order to perfect the Docket.

On August 29, 2023, the Court received a second letter from Mr. Allensworth. Doc. No. [240].<sup>1</sup> On August 7, 2023, Mr. Allensworth first wrote to the Court and commented on potential remedies in this matter. Doc. No. [226]. The Court issued an order informing Mr. Allenswoth that “[i]t is improper to

write letters to the Court.” Doc. No. [227], 1 (citing Jenkins v. Penney, CV 107-034, 2007 WL 9711224, at \*1 (S.D. Ga. Apr. 23, 2007)). The Court also informed Mr. Allensworth that no action would be taken on his letter because “[t]he Court has not made any findings of fact or conclusions of law regarding liability.” Doc. No. [227], 2. On August 29, 2023, the Court received a second letter from Mr. Allensworth, which again seems to comment on potential remedies in this Action.

Because this is Mr. Allensworth’s second letter to the Court this month and because, as stated above, it is improper to write letters to the Court for purposes of public comment, the Court finds that in the interest of preserving judicial resources, the appropriate course of action is a standing lodge order for any future filings by Mr. Allensworth. The Court **DIRECTS** the Clerk to add the language “DOCUMENT LODGED” to the CM/ECF descriptions for Doc. Nos. [226] and [240] and lodge any future filings from Mr. Allensworth in a similar manner. Lodged documents will not be considered.
