DEFENDANTS' UNOPPOSED MOTION TO INCREASE PAGE LIMITS

Defendants, by and through counsel, respectfully request the Court allow a five (5) page increase of the twenty-five (25) page limit outlined in Local Rule 7.01 and applicable to their motion to dismiss. Governor William B. Lee ("Governor Lee") will raise arguments in a F.R.C.P. 12(b)(6) motion that are distinct from those of the other Defendants. Instead of filing separate F.R.C.P. 12(b)(6) motions on behalf of Governor Lee and the remaining State Defendants, Defendants request that the page limit of such a motion be increased to thirty (30) pages.
