ORDER ON PLAINTIFFS' UNOPPOSED MOTION TO MODIFY SCHEDULING ORDER

Plaintiffs' request the modification of several intermediate deadlines set out in the court's Scheduling Order, Doc. 84. Because Defendants do not oppose this request and because none of these modifications should affect the trial-ready date in this case, the Court **GRANTS** Plaintiffs' motion and **MODIFIES** the Scheduling Order to reflect the following new deadlines. All other deadlines in the Scheduling Order remain in effect.

• Expert Testimony: Unless modified by stipulation of the parties, the disclosures of expert witnesses—including a complete report under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 26(a)(2)(B) from any specially retained or employed expert—are due:

From plaintiffs: Initial Reports by February 2, 2024

Rebuttal Reports by April 19, 2024

From defendants: March 29, 2024

- **Discovery Deadline:** All discovery must be commenced in time to be completed by **April 26, 2024.**
- **Dispositive Motions:** All potentially dispositive motions and evidentiary submissions upon which a party will rely in support of the motion must be filed no later than **May 31, 2024**.
 - O Should a motion for summary judgment be filed, any opposition to the motion must be filed no later than **June 28**, **2024**. Any reply brief in support of the motion must be filed no later than **July 12**, **2024**.
