In support thereof, the State Board Members state as follows:

When this complaint was filed, nine then-members of the State Board of Elections and Ethics Enforcement were sued in their official capacities. Before filing an answer in this matter, on 28 December 2018 those members ceased their membership on the State Board. On 7 January 2019, the State Defendants, including the State of North Carolina and the State Board of Elections, filed their answer to the Amended Complaint. On 31 January 2019, the State Board Members were appointed to the State Board of Elections. The State Board Members in their official capacities are automatically substituted as defendants in this case. *See* N.C. Gen Stat. §1A-1, Rule 25(f).

The State Board Members join in the answer previously filed by the State Defendants on 7 January 2019. The State Board Members also join the discovery responses served to date by the State Defendants.
