BY THE COURT:

Before the Court is Appellant's "Time-Sensitive Renewed and Amended Motion to Consolidate and Expedite and for Other Relief."

The motion is GRANTED, IN PART, to the extent the Court consolidates case no. 20-10394 with consolidated case nos. 18-11510 and 18-13510 for merits disposition.

The motion is DENIED, IN PART, to the extent it asks the Court to dispense with the briefing requirement in case no. 20-10394 entirely. Instead, the Court DIRECTS that:

(1) within 21 days after the date of this order, Wright file a supplemental brief, containing no more than 20 pages, concerning the relevance, if any, of the remedial proceedings underlying case no. 20-10394 to the merits of the consolidated cases; and

(2) within 21 days after the deadline for Wright's supplemental brief, the County file a response brief, containing no more than 20 pages.

By the filing date of each party's supplemental brief, each party may file supplemental appendices, as necessary, with materials not included in appendices filed in case nos. 18-11510 and 18-13510.

The motion is DENIED, IN PART, to the extent it requests that the cases be resolved without oral argument, and the motion is GRANTED, IN PART, to the extent it requests expedited oral argument. The Clerk is DIRECTED to place these cases on the next available argument calendar following the completion of supplemental briefing.
