The witnesses Proposed Senate Democratic Caucus Intervenors would call at the hearing the proposed intervening Democratic State Senators listed below and the

substance of their testimony would include facts that are primarily a matter of public record. As such, Proposed Senate Democratic Intervenors intend to seek a stipulation of facts from the Carter Petitioners as to the proposed witness testimony. In the event the Carter Petitioners do not agree to stipulate, Proposed Senate Democratic Caucus Intervenors intend to call the following witnesses:

State Senator Jay Costa to the following: He is a member of the Senate of Pennsylvania representing the 43rd Senate District including Allegheny County. Senator Costa serves as Leader of the Senate Democratic Caucus. Senator Costa resides in the precinct of the eighth district, Forest Hills Borough, Allegheny County and is registered to vote and resided in the 18th Congressional District. Re-election for the next term for the 43rd Senate District will be in the fall of 2024.

State Senator Vincent J. Hughes to the following: He is a member of the Senate of Pennsylvania representing the 7th Senate District including Montgomery and Philadelphia Counties. Senator Hughes serves as the Democratic Chair of the Senate Appropriations Committee. Senator Hughes resides in the precinct of the twelfth division of the fifty-second ward, Philadelphia and is registered to vote and resides in the 3rd Congressional District. Re-election for the next term for the 7th Senate District will be in the fall of 2024.

State Senator Wayne D. Fontana to the following: He is a member of the Senate of Pennsylvania representing the 42nd Senate District including Allegheny County. Senator Fontana serves as Chair of the Senate Democratic Caucus. Senator Fontana resides in the precinct of the twenty-seventh precinct of the nineteenth ward, Pittsburgh, Allegheny County and is registered to vote and resides on the 18th Congressional District. Re-election for the next term for the 42nd Senate District will be in the fall of 2022.

State Senator Judy Schwank to the following: She is a member of the Senate of Pennsylvania representing the 11th Senate District including Berks County. 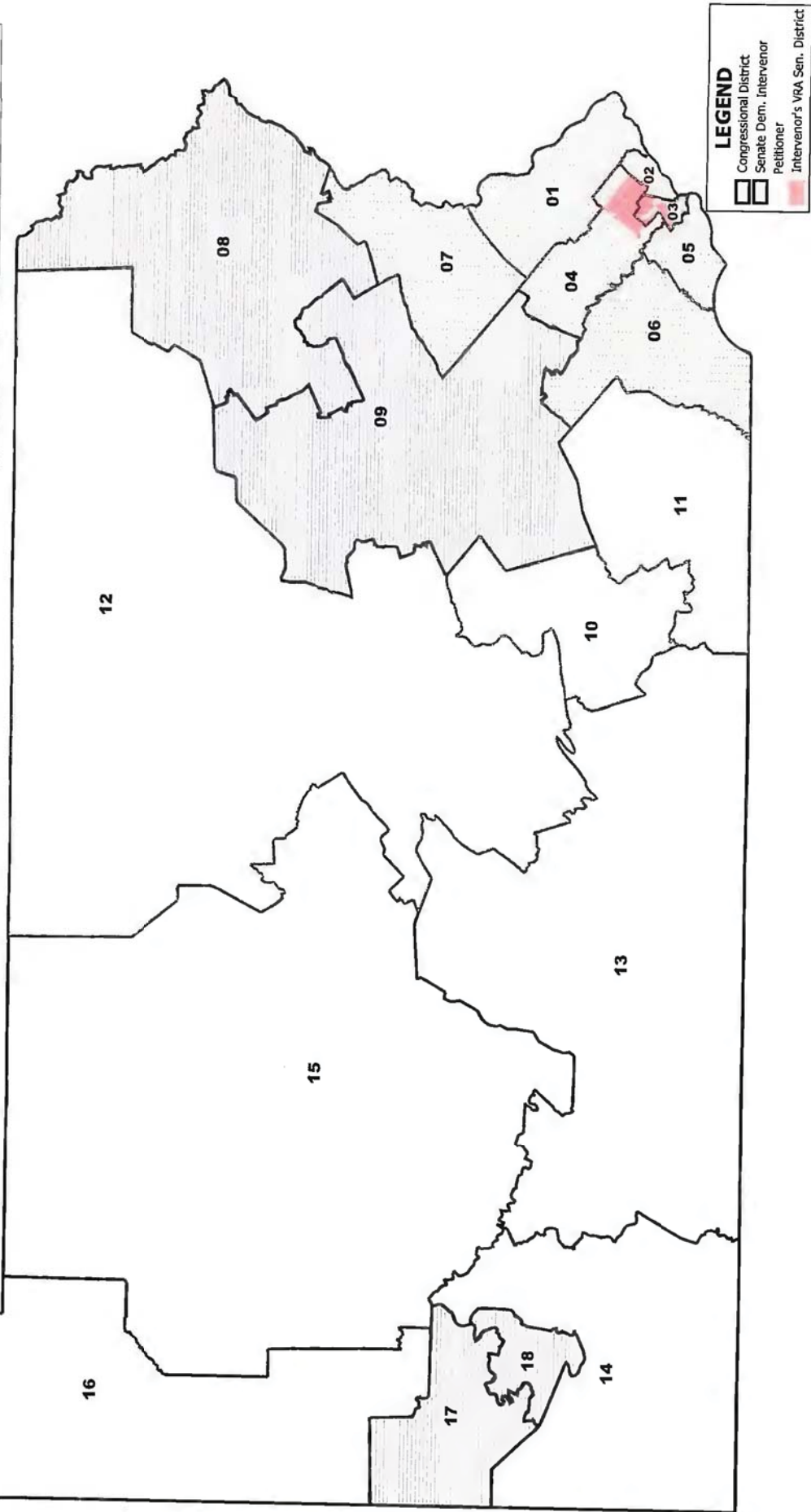
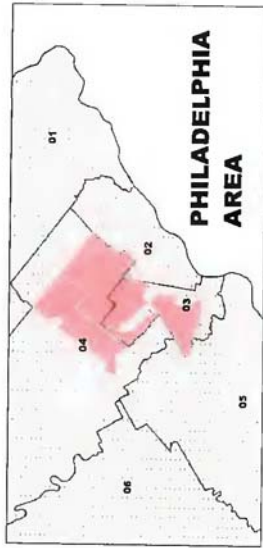
