Dear Ms. Grosko:

Today, the Chief Justice entered an order scheduling a hearing on March 1, 2022, under the above referenced case numbers. See R.C. 2705.02. Such a matter is considered a "special proceeding." In re Contempt of Common Pleas Court, 30 Ohio St.2d 182, 187, 283 N.E.2d 126, (1972). It is "a new and independent proceeding" that is auxiliary to the main action. See Hansen v. Hansen, 132 Ohio App.3d 795, 799, 726 N.E.2d 557 (1999), quoting 17 Corpus Juris Secundum, Contempt, Section 62(6), at 159-160 (1963).

It is possible that in this special proceeding the court could consider sanctions directed at individual members of the redistricting commission. *See* R.C. 2705.05. Because of this possibility, I intend to recuse myself from the March 1, 2022, hearing and the consideration of matters related thereto.
